This Saturday & Sunday (Trent Head)

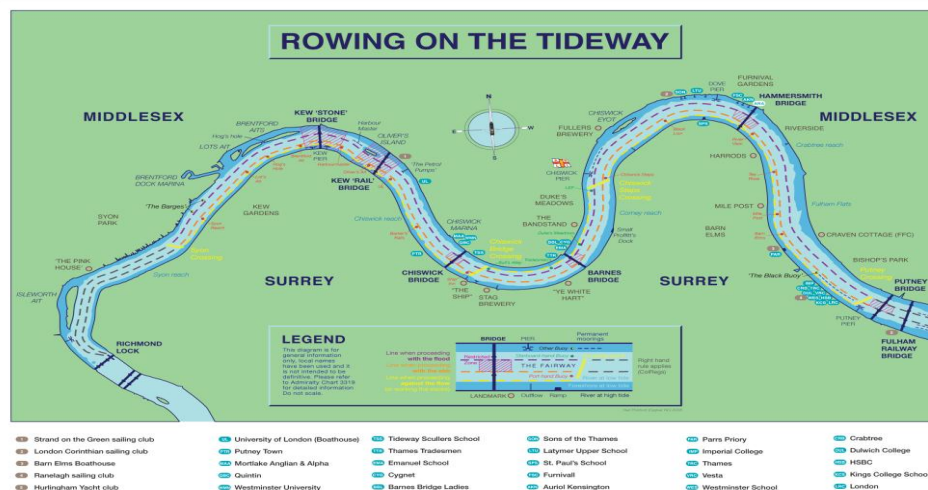
