Inter-Regional's Success for all three King's crews

32 points out of 36 for King's crews at Inter-Regional's

The weekend saw a conclusion to a successful few weeks for the rowing club. With the season opener at Ghent yielding 4 gold, 1 silver and 3 bronze medals. The club's inter-regional's representatives went to Nottingham this weekend in good form.

King's had qualified three crews for the North-West team, which takes on the 11 other regions in the U.K. over the 1500 metre course at Nottingham. Each crew returned with medals, the boys under 14 quad came a competitive third, the girls under 14 quad went one better winning the silver medals. The curtain raiser of the day was the boys under 16 eights event, which was the last race of the day. King's led the race before losing out by a canvas to arch rivals Hampton School, a close race which rewarded the crew with a silver medal and an already much anticipated rematch at Wallingford Regatta next weekend.
