**Assessment Information – J1 (Year 3)

The assessments will take place in the morning on **Saturday 16th January 2016**.

We aim to make the morning as informal, friendly and relaxing as possible. A short cartoon is shown whilst the children assemble and the Head of the Junior School will talk to the children, all aimed to put them at their ease. A light snack is made available during the course of the morning.

Children will be assessed in relation to the National Curriculum programme of study for Year 2. The work is designed to assess potential as well as achievement.

Whilst there will be tests in Mathematics (including mental arithmetic), English (including elements of grammar, comprehension and creative writing,) Reading and Reasoning, there will also be the opportunity to talk informally with teachers, in order for us to gauge social interaction skills. We ask for reports from children's schools to also assist us in our overall assessment.

Past papers are not available, although summary details of the content of the tests are overleaf.

If you wish your child to sit the assessment, please complete and return the registration form together with the non refundable exam entry fee of **£50** (cheque payable to **The King's School**). Your registration form should reach the school no later than **11th January 2016**.
