



## **Skeleton Resolution – Economic and Political Committee**

***Topic: The issue of illegal immigration in developed countries and providing short, medium and long term strategies***

*Acknowledges concern regarding the distribution of resources to both domestic and immigrant citizens, alongside the societal integration.*

*All decisions must be considered with respect to the maximisation of global peace. The safety of legal and illegal immigrants must always be an utmost priority.*

### **The UN:**

1. **Calls Upon** all member states to:
  - a. Tighten borders, increasing defences against illegal migration
  - b. Increase investigations into the common demographic and location of illegal migration
  - c. All with the purpose of setting precedent to minimise illegal immigration
  
2. **Encourages** developed member states to devise short-term strategies for the re-location of illegal immigrants, up to and including deportation to a safe and habitable place
  
3. **Demands** that all member states combatting illegal immigration resist physical enforcement:
  - a. With threat to any human life, until absolutely necessary
  - b. At the discretion of the relevant state
  
4. **Recommends** that all member states suffering illegal immigration
  - a. Orchestrate medium and long-term quotas with subject developing states
  - b. To establish legislation (annual numbers) from developing countries
  - c. Facilitate resources for legal and illegal immigrants, not limited to housing and food
  
5. **Requests** that all decisions from developed member states must be made:
  - a. In the absence of any discriminatory outlook
  - b. With purely economic and humanitarian motivations
