



Skeleton Resolution – Environment Committee (Beginners)

Topic: The issue of humanitarian aid and support for the current Australian wildfires.

Concerned by the increasing intensity and frequency of wildfires globally, exaggerated by global warming and climate change,

Emphasises the significance of the growing threat of wildfires to the global environment and understanding the humanitarian crisis that impacted communities face,

Recognises the responsibility in coordinating a response to provide both immediate and long term aid and solutions to Australia,

The UN:

1. **Calls upon** all member states to:
 - a. Place an immediate ban on all firecrackers, smoking, guns and campfires in high risk areas during periods of drought
 - b. Ensure all equipment of frequent use in areas of woodland/ forest are serviced every 2 months
2. **Calls upon** the formation using member states' funding of task force FIRES (first initiative for resources and emergency supplies) to:
 - a. Investigate efficient distribution of food and water in areas of difficult access
 - b. Coordinate emergency assistance to those in difficulty
 - c. Encourages a stock of medical resources and aid ready to access in affected areas
3. **Encourages** investment into research and technology for early detection and monitoring of wildfires for countries of risk
4. **Urges** protection of impacted and endangered animals under charities and NGO's such as FIRES
