



Skeleton Resolution – Health Committee

Topic: The issue of controlling the spread of Ebola

Notes that member states are forced to remain vigilant of the casualties attached to another outbreak,

Concerned that a virus outbreak may be a threat leading to significant and uncontrollable consequences affecting the global audience,

Recognises the importance of potential long-term aid,

The UN:

1. **Calls upon** member states to tighten borders and drastically reduce inflow of persons and goods from high-risk countries to prevent potential spread of Ebola
2. **Demands** member states to fund suffering countries with:
 - a. Monetary Aid
 - b. Humanitarian Aid
 - c. Appropriate vaccines and medical support
3. **Encourages** member states to prioritise the production of Ebola vaccines in their own internal medicinal manufacture to be distributed to suffering countries
4. **Urges** all member states to include Ebola awareness into their educational curriculums as to ensure that future generations are more aware of the virus, and the dangers that accompany any transmissions of it
