



Skeleton Resolution – Security and Disarmament Committee (Advanced)

Topic: The issue of a rising number of coups in Africa

Alarmed by the recent events that have unfolded in Burkina Faso, Niger and Gabon.

Recognises that African nations are resorting to military and political coups more frequently with complete disregard for liberal democracy, a path that may find tyranny and oppression follow swiftly behind.

Expecting to see international cooperations in such a way that may resolve any political discourse that leads to coups, and ultimately subjects the citizens to limitations on their individual liberty.

The UN:

1. **Recommends** the creation of an organisation, bringing together executive branches of African Nations to lessen hostility both internally and externally between states.
2. **Calls upon all member states:**
 - a. To support the creation of an African Election Fund, that aims to support free and fair elections without rigging and corruption in nations deemed politically unstable.
 - b. To remove authority of the military to police citizens, opting for an independent police force.
 - c. Wherein political and military coups have occurred, to continue functioning as liberal democracies, promoting its principles with entrenched legislation.
 - d. Fight against nepotism within military command structures, in order to deter corrupt leadership that may wish to seize control of a state.
3. **Demands** a review of international law, that would allow unstable countries that have undergone a coup to be invaded if weapons of significant threat are present. (Namely nuclear weapons)
