



Skeleton Resolution – UNOOSA Committee

Topic: The issue of the proliferation of space debris.

Recognising the increasing concern over the proliferation of space debris and its potential risks to space activities.

Emphasises the importance of preserving outer space for the present and future generations

1. **Calls Upon** all member states to:
 - a) Enhance their monitoring and tracking capabilities of space debris along with sharing relevant data and information with the international community.
 - b) Develop and implement national space debris mitigation guidelines, including debris prevention measures including end-of-life disposal procedures.
 - c) Encourage the removal of non-working satellites and large pieces of space debris from key orbits through responsible and coordinated means.

2. **Urges** all member states to:
 - a) Collaborate regionally and internationally to develop norms and guidelines for space debris mitigation and space traffic management
 - b) Support research and development efforts for technologies aimed at reducing space debris
 - c) Strengthen their commitment to the long-term sustainability of outer space activities.
