

You will see in the ISI report that King's was compliant in the majority of the regulatory categories. You will also note our excellent standards of student attainment compared to other schools, with both GCSE and A level results over recent years well above the maintained (state) sector and also above the maintained selective sector (grammar schools). Our parents gave us overwhelmingly positive responses with almost all giving responses 'agreeing' favourably at 90%+ levels regarding various statements about the school. Exceptionally high (96%+) responses were received for:

- A suitable range of subjects
- Teaching enabling good progress
- The quality of learning in a healthy and safe environment
- The promotion of British values · The active promotion of good behaviour
- Proper supervision during the school day
- Well maintained premises and accommodation
- School information being readily available
- Timely and helpful responses to questions, concerns or complaints
- Governance, leadership and management

There were also many positive references to the introduction of our new house system and various changes that have recently been made. Whilst we are delighted with such excellent and encouraging feedback, we are not complacent and will always strive to improve in areas where we are already well regarded but could do even better.

Regrettably, the inspectors judged that we were non-compliant in one specific area relating to recruitment checks carried out by our third party catering contractors and unfortunately this has a knock on effect for overall management compliance. Since the inspection, we have applied a number of additional measures to ensure that our catering contractors are meeting their obligations with regard to staff recruitment checks and we are now fully assured that these are taking place. I can assure you that no pupil has been put at any risk at any time and that safeguarding remains our top priority.
