



Included in your pack

- A cut-out photo of a person or people
- A small square or rectangle of foam board.
- If your photo is of a person or people in a sitting down pose you may also find a small triangle of foam board too
- A coffee stirrer
- Two or three squares of paper

What you will need

- A pair of scissors
- A glue stick
- Some coloured pens or pencils
- Your imagination

Step-by-step instructions

- Tape the placard to the coffee stirrer.
- Think about how your person will hold the placard and use a pair of scissors to make a small cut in the photo. You might also need a tiny bit of glue to help hold things in place.
- Once you've attached the placard to the person you should make a tiny slot in the foam board with your scissors so that the feet from the photo will fit in snugly
- This is where you might need to use the small triangle. If your person/people are sitting down you should attach the triangle to one side of the foam board so it stands up on its side.
- Once you've done that you can then attach the photo and it should look like they are sitting down comfortably
