


STAFF WELLBEING & & BENEFITS WORKING AT KING'S

Our school sits on the outskirts of Chester, within 33 acre grounds of The Grosvenor Estate.

We have 4 distinct schools – Willow Lodge (age 4-7 years), The Junior School (age 7-11 years), The Senior School (age 11-16 years) and Sixth Form (age 16-18 years).

We have a swimming pool, theatre, an all-weather floodlit pitch, sports pitches, and our recently developed £4.5m Sports Centre.

FREE 24 HOUR HEALTH, WELLBEING AND MENTAL HEALTH ADVICE AND SUPPORT

We offer our Employee Assistance Programme through Health Assured which includes a free 24 hour confidential advice line available every day of the year.



MEDICAL SUPPORT

Staff have access to a free annual flu vaccine during the Michaelmas (Autumn) Term.

We provide occupational health support for any colleagues with a specific need, whether this is before you join us, or during employment. Discounted group private health insurance is also available to staff via BUPA.



SPORTS & HEALTHY LIVING

All staff have free use of our onsite swimming pool and fully equipped onsite gym at designated times

We also offer subsidised Pilates with a professional instructor in our onsite Dance studio with views overlooking the grounds.

Staff run activities such as 5 aside football and social yoga.



STAFF WELLBEING

The school may arrange for a wellbeing therapist to come onsite to provide staff with complimentary seated back and shoulder massage, foot massage or reiki which proves a very popular initiative and spaces get booked up quickly.

SOCIAL EVENTS & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Our school employee forum (JSCC) has a budget set aside for social events and initiatives to reward and engage our staff for all of their hard work.

Activities include our annual Christmas dinner with prize draw (previous years have included luxury hampers, bottles of festive spirits and high street vouchers). We also hold an end of year Summer BBQ.

Staff also receive a complementary ticket to our school music and theatre productions.
